

TARDIS INSPIRED WRIST WARMERS:



Materials:

1 skein of Caron Simply Soft Party/ Royal Sparkle
4.5mm (us #7) double pointed needles
yarn needle to weave in loose ends.
scissors

Gauge: 4stitches / inch

Cast on:

38stitches, I divided them as follows, 12/14/12 that made it easier to knit the Tardis Patters as it is 14 stitches wide.

Cuff:

k1, p1 for 20 rows

Glove:

Knit 5 rows

Row1:

k12, p14, k12

Row2

k13, p12, k13

Row3 – 6:

k13, p2, k3, p2, k3, p2, k13

Row7:

k13, p12, k13

Repeat Row 3 -7 3x to a total of 4. (22rows of pattern)

Thumb hole left:

Row 17 at the beginning of the row, k3, bind off 6, k3 and then follow the tardis pattern.
 Next row, cast on 6st were you bound off.

Thumb hole right:

Row 17, knit to the tardis pattern you have 12, k3, bind off 6, k3 on the following row
 cast on 6 stitches where you bound off.

Row23:

k13, p2, k8, p2, k13

Row24

k13, p12, k13

Row25:

k14, p10, k14

Row26:

K15, p8, k15

Row27 & 28

k18, p2, k18

knit the next 5 rows.

Upper cuff:

k1, p1 for 5 rows, bind off.

You can also follow the diagram, X = purl
